



Below you will see the list of feeder calves that will be auctioned next Friday, October 14. There are 4 lots, 17 steers and 8 heifers, 25 in total. They were graded using USDA Feeder Calf Standards and sorted into similar weight groups. The spread is around 50 lb in each lot.

While this is a smaller offering than desired, these producers are committed to providing calves that are double vaccinated, weaned, on feed and drinking from waterers. We think that you will be pleased with the results. The calves all qualify for “all natural” having never been given antibiotics or treated with growth promoting hormones.

They will be sold at auction by Dann Auctioneers on October 14, 2:00 pm.
