

Campus Code of Conduct

The university is required by law to have, and to enforce regulations for the maintenance of public order. These are incorporated in the Campus Code of Conduct, which also includes general principles regarding the university's governance of community conduct, regulations for the maintenance of the educational environment, an explanation of the university judicial structure and procedure, and institutional policy concerning responsible speech and expression. The code applies equally to students and to faculty and staff, to the extent that faculty and staff conduct arises outside the scope of employment. (Alleged misconduct that arises in the course of employment will be addressed by the appropriate university administrative office or department head.) Where applicable, the code specifies means of enforcement, penalties that may be applied, and the jurisdiction of hearing and review boards.
