

## Student Information

Cornell University maintains present and former students' personal information and records, and is responsible for their custody, release, and alteration. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) requires that students be advised of their rights concerning certain personal or educational records maintained by an institution or by a party acting on behalf of that institution. Improper maintenance, disposal, or release of information about a present or former student exposes the university to significant risk. Persons should become familiar with and review annually, the Student Record Privacy Statement: Annual Notification Under FERPA (<http://www.cornell.edu/academics/courses.cfm>) as well as the Access to Student Information Policy prior to releasing any information ([https://www.dfa.cornell.edu/sites/default/files/vol4\\_5.pdf](https://www.dfa.cornell.edu/sites/default/files/vol4_5.pdf)) prior to releasing any information.
