

University ROTC Relations Committee Summary Report
2011-2012 Academic Year

The only activities of the URRC for the 2011-2012 Academic Year were to meet for purposes of interviewing and approving proposed new faculty for the 3 ROTC branches as needs arose. A total of three meetings were held, one on 19 Jan. 2012, one on 21 Feb. 2012, and the final one on 23 May 2012. The committee interviewed a total of 4 candidates, two candidates to teach for the Navy detachment and one each for the Air Force and Army detachments. All 4 interviews were conducted via Skype because the candidates were overseas at the time or because conducting the interviews this way eased our scheduling dilemmas. All four candidates were approved.

The committee did not have any significant challenges this year. The committee does not anticipate any significant challenges for the coming year. Note that the committee could, in principle, get involved in other aspects of ROTC relations with the university. To date, a pressing need for this has not emerged.
