Show Information: The Beef Show will take place on **Saturday, July 28, 2018 at 9am**, at the Ward O'Hara Agricultural Museum, 6880 East Lake Road, Auburn, NY 13021. All animals must be in place by Noon on Thursday, July 26th. Tentative Release Time will be Saturday, July 28th at approximately 5:00pm.

A NOTE ON OUR CURRENT FACILITIES...

- Camper Hook-ups for power-only will be extremely limited. Many local hotels are available or you may sleep in the tent or alongside your animals.
- Animals WILL BE housed in TENTS! These tents have limited electrical hook-ups so plan accordingly. Bring extension cords and be willing to use designated areas for clipping if need be. The more fitting you do at home, the better.
- Initial bedding (straw) will be PROVIDED for Cattle Exhibitors at **NO COST**, to allow you to bring MORE ANIMALS AND LESS MATERIALS!
- Sleeping tents will be allowed, but must be taken down EACH morning.

Ground Rules:

In order to maintain safety to all fair attendees and exhibitors, The Fair Committee has established the following Ground Rules:

- Overnight in the Tent – Absolutely no one under the age of 18 is allowed to stay/be in the tents without a chaperone after 10PM. Only exhibitors are allowed to stay/be on the grounds. All others must seek approval from the Fair committee and file necessary paperwork.
- Any youth exhibitor wishing to stay overnight with their animals must fill out and submit an Overnight Request Form. These forms are currently being updated, and will be available soon.
- Tents will close at 10PM and lights out at 11PM.
- NO ALOCOHOL IS PERMITTED IN THE TENTS AT ANY TIME.
- Manure is to be placed in or on the side of the dumpster where signs are placed.
- The tent aisle and wash rack areas are to be kept free of grooming tools, equipment, hair and manure. PLEASE clean up after your animal. Keep outside of the tent clean and free of hay, straw and manure.
- Exhibitors and their families will act kind and cooperative at all times.

Class K – Market Steer	*Steer Classes will be determined based on weights at show so make all entries under Class K
