### **Digital Storytelling for the 21st Century**

Youtube is cool...but there are other interesting ways to tell stories. During this session we'll explore digital storytelling - using audio, images and video to create compelling stories for the web. We will cover the basics of interviewing to reveal and capture stories, how to edit interviews for presentation and how to evaluate images and videos for use in a story. Bring digital cameras, pictures and story ideas. We'll provide the tools. Together we'll tell some stories.

##### **Tuesday July 1, 2008**

2:00 pm – 4:30 pm - Storytelling – digital or otherwise. During this time we will discuss interviewing – how to evoke stories, what happens when things are edited, does a story have to be factual to be true?

We'll also discuss and decide what stories we want to tell during our time together, what formats or tools are most appropriate and form into working groups.
