

# 2019 Poetry Contest

The New York State 4-H Dog Program is providing another opportunity for dog lovers to demonstrate their creative talents! Young poets (age 5 - 19) will have an opportunity to have their original work displayed at the NYS Fair **August 21 – September 2, 2019**.

### Entries must be postmarked by July 15, 2019.

#### Who may enter?

Youth currently affiliated with any CCE 4-H Youth Development Program in New York State.

#### **Eligibility:**

Contestants must give permission for their creative writing to be displayed and used for publicity.

#### What types of poetry may be submitted? Please limit your entries to limericks or haikus.

Limerick: a rhymed poem of 5 lines. Haiku: Japanese poetry of 17 syllables divided into 3 lines of 5, 7 and 5 syllables.

#### Limerick example (dog agility):

My dog doesn't run in the rain, She thinks getting wet is a pain, She hides in the chute, I think she's a hoot, But she thinks that I am insane. *by Kathleen Truesdell*  Haiku sample (dog agility): Run and jump and turn! Agility partners' dream.

### Suggested Categories:

Dog Science / Dog Sports / Dog Jobs / Best Friend / 4-H Dog Activity / Dog Breeds Around the World

#### **Judging Criteria:**

Limericks & haikus will be evaluated on the following criteria, by a panel of 4-H educators, public educators and dog enthusiasts.

- 1. Adherence to the limerick or Haiku structure
- 2. Original thought and perspective
- 3. Clarity of expression

How Many Poems May I Enter: There is a limit of 3 entries per youth.

**Winners:** Winners will be announced & displayed in the Dog Science / Cynology Display at the **2019** NYS Fair – Youth building.

#### How do I enter?

- ✓ Completed entry forms may be handwritten or typed.
- ✓ All entries become the property of Cornell and will not be returned.
- ✓ Each entry must be accompanied by a signed (photo, video and audio consent) release form.
