This year, the 2020 NYS 4-H Horse Communications contest will be conducted virtually using Youtube as a platform.

Regions may choose four senior individual presentations, four junior individual presentations, four senior public speeches, four junior public speeches, four senior team presentations, and four junior team presentations from their regions. These can be those who qualified at the regional contest, or those chosen in any other manner that seems fit for your region.

Registration will begin on Friday, July 31st using the registration link below. Only CCE County Educator or staff can register youth; all registrations need to be submitted by August 21st at 11:59pm. Beginning Friday, July 31st, educators will be able to upload their youths videos as unlisted so that only those who have the link can view, and these links will be shared with the appropriate judges. The registration form will ask for youth's contact information, speech information, an unlisted Youtube link to their speech, and permission to share the link to their video with judges and other participants.

Placings will be announced via email by Tuesday, September 1st, along with a listing a speech titles and corresponding Youtube links so that youth may enjoy the speeches from their peers. The award announcement will also include a signup list with available times slots for youth to arrange for a one-on-one session with a judge to go over their speech over zoom or phone call. Ribbons, scoresheets, and certificates will be mailed to participants.
