

Identifying Plant Differences

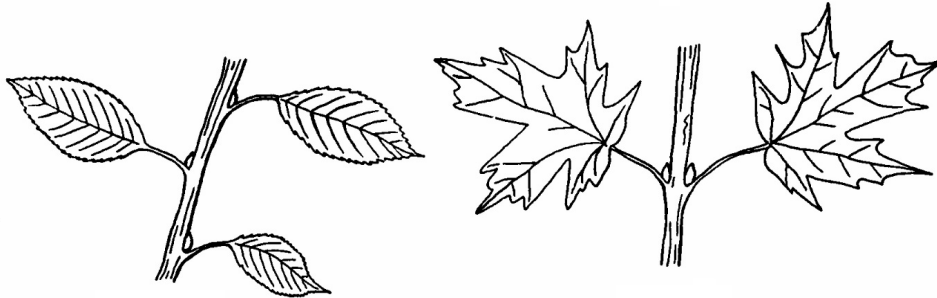
This self-check worksheet aims to help you practice and evaluate your understanding of botany terminology in identification of plant characteristics.

Activity:

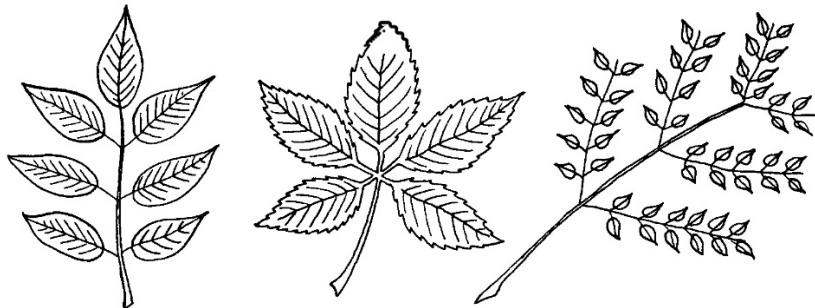
- Identify the bud and leaf arrangement for each twig. Is it opposite, alternate or whorled?
