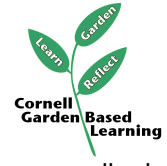


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2017-2018 Cornell Garden-Based Learning Leadership Certificate & Mini-Grant Application Guidelines

Submission: Please submit a 2-3 page single-spaced proposal, explaining why your team is interested in the CGBL Leadership Certificate *and* outlining your plans for a garden-based learning project in your county program.

Required:

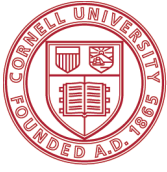
- Please provide the name, contact information and positions of the proposed team members.

Preference will be given to proposals that explicitly address the following:

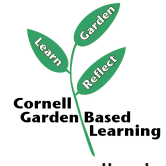
- Why is your team interested in the CGBL Leadership Certificate? What do you hope to gain? How will you apply what you've learned?
- What are the logistics of your garden-based learning project proposal? Please expand on the details of who, what, when, where and how.
- How will the proposed project creatively engage the community?
- What ways will the proposed project engage diverse audiences?
- Tell us specifically how will the proposed project integrate approaches from the various county programs represented on this team, as well as how will it genuinely forge connections between 4-H youth development and other program areas.
- How are participating county-based educators currently involved in professional development efforts such as CGBL Educator Enrichment or CCE Program Development Leadership Certificate?
- Who will be responsible for reporting your successes? Who will capture documentation in photos and provide progress reports?
- As you look ahead, what would you image that "success" might look like? What are your hoped for outcomes as a result of this leadership experience and project support?
- What questions about Cooperative Extension and garden-based education are you currently holding at this time?
