



Teacher's Quick Start to Blogging with CampusPress

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Login

Go to <http://blogs.lcps.org> and login with your LCPS Google account.

Create your teacher blog

1. Click on *My Sites* (top left) and then *Add New*
2. Scroll down on the LCPS blog home page and enter info for your new blog
3. Consider *only administrators* or the *password* option initially.
4. Scroll down on the LCPS blog home page and click on your blog's name to view the default blog
5. Customize and refine your blog by accessing the dashboard by hovering over your site title in the top black menu bar.

Make your teacher blog a class blog

1. Follow the step-by-step instructions available here:

2. Pay close attention to the privacy and moderation settings upon creation of your class blog. These can be edited later.

Create or associate student blogs

You can associate existing student blogs with your class blog or you can create blogs for each of your students. Follow these steps:

Confirm privacy and moderation settings

Using the *My Class* feature (found on the dashboard), a teacher can apply settings to all student blogs associated with a class blog. Settings include whether or not students can post to the class blog with or without moderation, whether comments have to be approved, and who has access to the class and student blogs.
