## GRE Substitution Request Form

If you are submitting the GRE Substitution Request form without formally applying, please send a copy of your transcripts and resume for consideration. If you are submitting the GRE Substitution Request form with your application, we will review your transcripts and resume with your application package.

### GRE Substitution

**Please check that you meet all of the criteria below to have your GRE Substitution Request form considered.**

- GRE must be taken no less than 18 months of the MBA application date and within the past 5 years.
- GRE minimum score of 160 verbal and 150 quantitative.
- A GRE substitution will not be granted to any candidate who does not hold an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution
