Directions:

1A. If starting at 610 (South Loop) and Gulf Freeway exit East to Hwy 225 (La Porte Freeway). Go east to the Independence Parkway (Old Battleground Road) (134) exit.

1B. If starting from Hwy 146 at Hwy 225 exit to Hwy 225 and go West to the Independence Parkway (134) exit.

2. Exit Hwy 225 at Independence Parkway (134), and go North. Get in the left lane and continue North when the road splits East at Tidal Road. Continue North past Besaw's and the road will curve to the right (East). The Monument Restaurant is on the right just before the ferry.

3. If starting in Houston on I-10 go East and exit to S. Lynchburg Road. Go South and take the ferry. The Monument is on the immediate left as you drive off the ferry. The ferry closes at 8:15 PM.
