

The Dalles Main Street Organization is a 501©3 nonprofit that utilizes the National 4-Point approach to revitalize and historically preserve downtown The Dalles. The organization was formed in 2010 as a City initiative and has seen significant growth in the most recent 3 years. The Dalles Main Street recently became a "Performing Main Street" which is the highest level of performance in the Oregon State Main Street program.

Jeremiah will be working on the preservation and improvement of downtown historic facades which is a priority of the City, Historic Landmark Commission and Main Street. He will also focus on improving communication and increase the participation of volunteers, downtown business owners, and other organizations.
