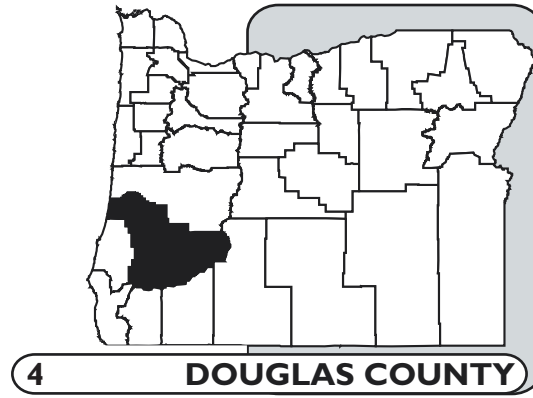

Assignment The RARE participant in Winston will work with the City on an array of planning projects. Currently, Winston has no full time planning staff and contracts for planning services with Douglas County. The participant will work to increase city planning capacity by working with the county planner on the following: transportation apportionment; a floodplain ordinance update; the creation and construction of a bicycle/pedestrian trail; helping modernize city planning records; and helping with any extra assistance needed by either the county planner or Winston city staff.

Required Skills The ideal participant will need strong communication skills and should be willing to work with a wide range of personalities. The participant should be comfortable conducting research, documenting process, developing and writing grants, and working with volunteers. A background in city planning would be very useful.
