Assignment

The RARE Participant will be working on the preparation and submittal of the National Historic District Nomination for the downtown core of the City of Klamath Falls. This project entails a number of components. The participant will create a "historic district design guidelines" information brochure, identify and publicize potential sources of funding and assistance for rehabilitation projects, provide advice and assistance to property owners on potential and actual rehabilitation projects, work with the Downtown Urban Renewal Advisory Board and staff to implement other downtown improvement programs, and assist staff and community members in identification of possible additional historic districts and preservation strategies.

The participant will be involved in a number of the following activities to fulfill the National Historic District Nomination: historic preservation research, preparation of informational materials, photography, preparation of a brochure for publication and distribution, collection of information for building owners, provision of advise and assistance as needed, and management of actual improvement projects.

Required Skills

Required skills for this position are excellent research and writing skills; knowledge of historic preservation, architecture, building styles and construction technology; graphic skills and publication layout skills; and good communication skills.
