

## Psychology Major Checklist

- **Requirements: 56 total psychology credit hours. 48 upper division psychology credit hours (includes 16 at UO).**
- Introductory and methods courses are prerequisites for core courses at the upper level; see course schedule for specifics.
- **PSY 201 and 202 must be taken graded and passed with a C or higher. All other courses, except electives, must be taken graded and passed with a C- or higher.** Electives may be taken P/N and students must receive a P.
- **PSY 410 courses (except for Evolutionary Psychology) count toward elective credits only.**
- **Minimum GPA of 2.0 in psychology coursework required.**

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### Introductory/Prerequisite Courses – 8 credits: (Each class equals 4 credits, taken **graded, C or higher**)

PSY 201 \_\_\_\_\_ AND PSY 202 \_\_\_\_\_ (pre-requisites for PSY 302-309)

### Other prerequisite courses (not included in psychology credit hours; must be taken graded and passed with a C- or higher)

WR 121 \_\_\_\_\_ and WR 122 \_\_\_\_\_ or WR 123 \_\_\_\_\_ (WR 122 or 123 is a pre-requisite for PSY 303)

Math 243 \_\_\_\_\_ (recommended, but will accept Math 246, 251 or higher; pre-requisite for PSY 302)

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### 300-level Core Courses – 12 credits. Choose at least 3 and **must include 304 or 305**

(Each class equals 4 credits, taken **graded, C- or higher**. PSY 201 is a prereq for PSY 304 & 305; PSY 202 is a prereq for PSY 306-309, PSY301 recommended; See class schedule for specifics)

PSY 302 \_\_\_\_\_ (pre-requisites: PSY 201, 202, 301, Math 243, etc.) **Maximum of two attempts** in this course..

Math 425, 461, 462 may be substituted for PSY 302.

PSY 303 [Topic] \_\_\_\_\_ (pre-reqs are PSY 301, 302, WR 122 or 123). **Repeatable once when topic changes.**

PSY 303 is a prerequisite for 400-level psychology classes.

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### 400-level Specialty Courses– 12 credits. Choose at least 3

(Each class equals 4 credits, taken **graded, C- or higher**)

**(PSY 303 is a prerequisite for 400-level psychology classes.**

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\***Note:** Only PSY 410 Evolutionary Psychology counts toward core course requirements. All other PSY 410 courses count as elective credits only.

\*\* Only 4 credits of PSY 401 and/or PSY 409 will count toward the major elective credits requirements. Additional experiential learning credits count for university upper division credits.
