

# Faith Van Nice and Kuntz-Swinehart Scholarships

## Application Instructions

**Evaluation:** Candidates will be evaluated based on the overall quality of their academic work, their commitment to future learning and research and their potential for further academic achievement. If candidates are not planning to obtain an advanced degree, they should describe how their chemistry or biochemistry education has influenced their future career goals.

**Eligibility Requirements:** To be eligible for these awards, students must be enrolled full-time at the University of Oregon and be a declared major in Chemistry or Biochemistry. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a scale of 4.0 (or similar grade assessment).

**Application:** The application consists of the following materials:

**Cover page:** Please attach a cover page that includes the following information:

- 1) Full name
- 2) Postal address
- 3) Email address
- 4) Phone number

**Essay:** Prepare a one-page essay describing your academic achievements to date and your vision for your future contributions to the field of science. Essays must be typed on standard 8.5 x 11-inch paper, single-spaced using 11 Point Arial fonts with 1-inch margins. All essays must have your full name located in the footer and the words "Chemistry Scholarships" located in the header.

**Resume:** Please attach a two-page resume that includes non-academic activities and accomplishments.

**To submit your application:** Please bring your application materials to the Chemistry Department office in room 91 Klamath Hall in a sealed envelope addressed to Chemistry Scholarships, c/o Leah O'Brien, Department of Chemistry, University of Oregon. Applicants will receive an email response indicating that their materials have been received. **The application deadline is Monday, May 7, 2018 at 5 pm.**
