- **75 College Of Education Courses Delivered:** Over seventy five unique College of Education courses have been taught using The Office of Global and Online Education's (GOE) ObaVerse Learning Management System including courses in: American Sign Language, Educational Leadership, Education Studies, Family and Human Services, and Special Education. Many of these courses have been taught multiple terms.
- **Numerous university wide departments and unique projects supported** - The GOE continues to provide access to ObaVerse, professional development, technical support, and instructional design support to departments across campus. During the 2014 - 15 academic year the GOE has begun work with departments and units across campus to create stand-alone, customized Oba installs for their specific research and academic projects. Some recent examples include work with: The Center on Brain Injury Research and Training (CBIRT), The Center for Applied Second Language Studies (CASLS), the Department of Planning, Public Policy and Management, the History Department, the Brain Development Lab, the COE Internship Program, the Linguistics Department, The American English Institute and the COE's Office of Educational Community Supports.
- **Professional Development and Support** The Office of Global Education and Online Learning (GOE) provides individual and group professional development to faculty and staff across campus and globally with institutions in the following areas: online curriculum development, instructional design, digital learning, globalization in education, and the integration of new educational technologies.
- **Recent Grant Awards and Applications:** Technical/instructional design support and platform development is provided to State Toolkit for Examining Post-School Success (STEPSS) an IES Special Education Research Goal 2 Grant. GOE is sub-award recipient on 2 multi-year/multi-million dollar grants - an I3 grant (USDE Investing in Innovation (i3) Fund) with the Center for Applied Linguistics (CAL) in Washington D.C., and on an USDE Arts in Education Model Development and Dissemination Grant in partnership with Springfield School District, Oregon. Additionally we are a subcontractor supporting a Gates Grant awarded to (CAL). GOE is written into multiple grant proposals for 2015-16 including a NSF grant and an additional I3 grant.
- **K-12 & ObaWorld: 7 Countries, 16 US States, 3,000+ Teachers** The GOE provides thousands of hours of PD and technical support to secondary teachers around the world who are using our ObaWorld platform to meet their digital learning needs.
