II. Discussion

Chris Sinclair, Senate Vice President, visited the meeting and did an overview of the new Senate website. In order to maintain a current listing of UOCC documents, Chris said it was best if the committee kept it's own blog site which Frances had already created.

Repeatability policy – Sue reviewed the newest changes for the committee.

AEIS courses – There is no graduate program for these 600-level courses. The Graduate Council will need to be notified and advise UOCC on how to handles these courses.

PSY 479/579 – The differential is weak. There's concern about the photos on the syllabus. There were questions about the general ed request, course readings and the prerequisite.

Learning outcomes – Ron reminded the committee that the learning outcomes need to be filled out correctly in CourseLeaf.

ASIA 111 – Sounds like it may be a topics course because the book can be changed by whomever teaches the course and there are four teachers. There was concern about course sustainability because of the change of teachers. There was discussion on how the course could be formatted so that it always has the same objectives regardless of who teaches it by different books. There was a few questions about the general education and multicultural requests.
