GER 399 Food Studies: Frances stated they want to change this to GER 300 (experimental number). Being asked by dept. head to change for next term. No current syllabus yet.

CDS 631: Course was rolled back to department on 10/19/18 to change to topics course. Straw poll taken and committee approved, pending resubmission of course with requested changes made. CFT 609- Course withdrawn by department.

CFT 629 Intimate partner Therapy: SEI needs 160 hrs., only 130 listed

PPPM 646 Growth Management: Title and catalog description too vague, what type of “growth.” Catalog description and title should reflect that it is land growth.

PPPM 681 Nonprofit Financial Management: Potential overlap with Law. Due diligence needed. Course pushed to winter term for UOCC review.

BA 325 Business Law and Ethics, BE 325 Global, Legal, Social Environment of Business: Both syllabi are nearly identical; seemed to be cut/paste. Courses taught by same instructor. BA 325 states that it is replacing BE 325. Perhaps it should be a drop course, rather than existing course proposal on CourseLeaf. Need to clarify what exactly they want.

MGMT 321- missing from UOCC workflow in Courseleaf. Note: 11/12/18 – Course was withdrawn in Sept., 2018.

OBA 335H- missing from UOCC workflow in Courseleaf. Note: 11/12/18 – Course was rolled back to dept. in July, 2018.
