INTL 331 Global Leadership through Intercultural Living. Concern for how this course will fit into our 10-week term. Suggestion for proposer to call registrar

HIST 255 Pacif Hist: Isle, Ocn, Ppl. Needs title change, due diligence from ANTH missing (link is there but doesn't work), course description needs work

ANTH 278 Scientific Racism. Needs new Core Ed Criteria, video links don't work, no due diligence attached, vague title

PPPM 495 Graduate students enrolled in the class are not allowed to act like a GE, which is against policy. Syllabus indicates they are helping with the undergrad students

EDUC 616 Philosophy of Research: Exploring Foundational Questions. Title too long, no colon allowed, enrollment restrictions- COE students only?

CINE 370 Narrative Production II. 179 Engagement hours- concern for load on students. Does course need a credit increase?
