Some irregularities among the new course titles need to be addressed, and should probably be discussed with the course applicants by the various assigned committee members:

IARC 447/557 Color Theory and Application for the Built Environment (Title too long)

ENG 386 Body Comics (Title not ideally clear. Perhaps "The Body in Comics"?)

MATH 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, and 206 ("MathLab" is not one word. The title should either be "Math Lab," "Mathematics Laboratory," or a combination of those two with a requisite space between the terms.)

FHS 328 Human Development in the Family Context (Drop unnecessary term "Context" from title)

CRES 651 Academic Capstone – Course Concentration (Replace dash with colon to match catalog style for presenting subtitles)

J 654 Reporting with Community (Title doesn't scan. Perhaps "Reporting in the Community"?)
