Michelle Wood, CAS curriculum committee, was a guest and discussed the CASCC process. There was discussion regarding general education requirements, among other topics of mutual interest.

ARH 421/521 and other ARH course– There are a number of concerns regarding this course. There was discussion about this being a topics course when asking for multicultural status. The syllabus needs work. The titles needs changed. It is repeatable but doesn't say how many times. Other ARH courses also need work. Christian will be meeting with the department.

TA 409 – CL roll back to department.

HPHY 411 – The committee would like it noted on the UOCC winter report that this course will be a bucket course and would fall under Point 4, section d of the Credit-Bearing General Limitations to the Bachelor's Requirements. UOCC approved.

HIST 211 – UOCC approved.

HIST 411 – Add “advanced” to title. UOCC approved.

CAS 101 – Drop course. UOCC approved.

ANTH 224M – Need revised syllabus. Overlap concern with history. Course ready for vote once revised syllabus received.

PS 619 – Department has not responded to change requests made by the CAS curriculum committee or UOCC. CL roll back to department.

MUE 647 – UOCC approved pending Grad School approval.
