DEGREE REQUIREMENTS - 87 CREDITS

Individual requirements are determined by a transcript evaluation. Exact core courses taken will depend on the student's program of study. This degree is typically completed in 6 terms. This includes 40 credits in design studios. The remaining 47 credits are distributed among required professional coursework and professional electives, which include the seminar, advanced study, and history requirements.
