



MASTER OF INTERIOR ARCHITECTURE - TRACK I

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS - 147 CREDITS

Individual requirements are determined by a transcript evaluation. Exact core courses taken will depend on the student's program of study. This degree is typically completed in 10 terms. This includes 64 credits in design studios. The remaining 83 credits are distributed among required professional coursework and professional electives, which include the seminar, advanced study, and history requirements.
