- 1 - IARC 4/592 Electric Lighting must be taken concurrently with ARCH 4/606 Sp Pr Electric Light (the ARCH + the IARC class, at the appropriate level) to fulfill Advanced Technology requirement.
- 2 - ARCH 4/507 Digital Practice must be taken concurrently with ARCH 4/606 Sp Pr Digital Practice at the appropriate level to fulfill Advanced Technology requirement.
- 3 - This course must be taken for 4 credits to fulfill the Advanced Technology requirement. Otherwise, it will fill only a subject-area elective.
- 4 - B.ARCH students entering Fall 2018 and beyond have an history requirement of ARH 314, ARH 315 and any two additional Architectural history courses, as approved by the Department of Architecture for architectural history on this subject-area electives guide or previous iterations of it. B.ARCH students entering prior to Fall 2018 have a different history requirement, as outlined in the 2017-18 B.ARCH curriculum guide.
- 5 - Eligible subject-area elective for ARCH students only, not IARC students.

**Courses that are 400-level and below are for undergraduate students. Courses 500-level and above are for graduate students.**
