

How to Create an APA Reference Page

1. Go to BibMe at <http://www.bibme.org/>
2. Click on the colored tabs for "Book, Magazine, Newspaper, Website, Journal, Film, Other (Interview, Lecture, Radio/TV, Photograph)"
 - a. Remember to find the...
 - i. ISBN for a book or encyclopedia. If it does not work, manually type in the info.
 - ii. URL for a picture is NOT Google. Click on the picture to find the actual URL.
3. Create your references page on the site and transfer to a Word document.
4. After transferring the references, be sure to...
 - a. Use **Times New Roman, size 12 font, and 1 inch margins.**
 - b. The "References" **title is centered.** The rest of the page is **aligned to the left.**
 - c. The reference list is in **alphabetical order.**
 - d. The **1st line is NOT indented**, but every other **line after that is indented.** (Tab once)

Here is an example of what the reference page should look like... (Minus the arrows!)
