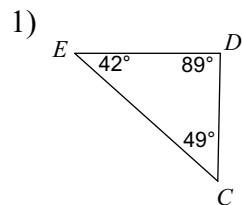
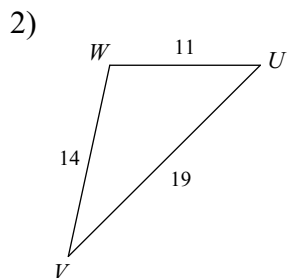


Triangle Inequality
