**Saturday, April 21 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Marion Orton Recycling Center**  
(735 W. North St.)

Join us at the Marion Orton Recycling Center for the Mayor's Earth Day Proclamation, followed by a city-wide trail cleanup and an invasive plant removal event along the Razorback Greenway near the Fayetteville Public Library. Trail Cleanup volunteers will be given supplies and a cleanup location on the trail system (carpooling is encouraged to reach outer trail areas). Volunteers helping remove invasive plants along the Razorback Greenway will meet at 10 a.m. at the former City Hospital parking lot (419 W. Rock St.) to receive supplies and instruction. Bagels, coffee and t-shirts provided at kickoff. Tools, supplies, snacks and water will also be provided at both locations. Please wear sturdy closed-toe shoes and weather appropriate clothing. This event is rain or shine, but may be delayed in the case of a downpour or thunder and lightning.

“Help make a difference in the Beaver Lake Watershed, improving and protecting our most precious natural resource -water! If you want to lend a hand, your help is needed at Mt. Sequoyah Woods, a 97-acre open greenspace in south Fayetteville. Mt. Sequoyah Woods is part of a National Fish & Wildlife Foundation project to promote a healthy ecosystem and wildlife in urban forests. This time, we'll be removing the highly invasive Amur Honeysuckle (*Lonicera mackii*) and Chinese Privet (*Ligustrum sinense*) to promote native plants for wildlife habitat. We'll meet at the Mt. Sequoyah Woods trailhead, located at 5 S Happy Hollow Rd, Fayetteville, AR and work from 3:00pm to 5:00pm. Gloves, tools, water, and hands-on training will be provided. Weather appropriate outdoor clothing and footwear recommended.”

“Help us keep our urban waterways clean! Town Branch Preserve, located along the Town Branch Trail in South Fayetteville, is an urban creek that provides a scenic backdrop for the paved multi-use trail while offering habitat for wildlife in an urban setting. As part of the Beaver Lake Watershed, the preserve also protects water quality for the drinking water source for the region. The purpose of this workday is to remove litter that accumulates in the creek and on the property. Supplies will be provided, but hip waders or mud boots are encouraged.”

We will meet at the Town Branch Trail access at Spectrum Apartments, beside the dog park. Parking is limited to visitor spots only. Thanks to Beaver Watershed Alliance for partnering with us to protect water quality through land conservation and stewardship!

Arbor Day is usually celebrated by planting trees, however this year, tree maintenance and a healthy understory will be the focus. This park was named after the late Clarence Craft, a World War II Medal of Honor recipient and active VA Medical Center volunteer. Volunteers will gain instruction on non-native invasive plant identification and removal techniques, and will help to remove bush honeysuckle and Chinese privet from the areas surrounding this hidden away park and quaint neighborhood pond. Water and tools will be provided, but volunteers are encouraged to wear protective clothing and must wear closed-toe sturdy shoes.
