D	<p>Engagement has been limited, as evidenced by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Journal entries that are limited, superficial and infrequent • Infrequent contact with supervisor • Limited research has been conducted • Limited method • Simple outline of future steps to be completed • The research question requires refinement and focus
E (failing grade; no credit towards NIS High School Diploma)	<p>Engagement has been minimal, as evidenced by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No journal entries on Managebac • No meetings with supervisor • No research has been conducted • No method • No outline of future steps to be completed • The research question is too broad, or inappropriate
