## Paper Plate Fact Quiz

Make a paper plate fact quiz to review or test country knowledge.

### Materials:

- Paper plate
- Question Wheel (page 72)
- Circular Cover (page 73)
- Glue
- Markers or colorful pencils
- Brass fastener
- Scissors

### Directions:

1. Research a country. Write 10 short questions and answers from the research.
2. Write one question beside each number on the outer ring of the question wheel. Write the answer to the right of the question on the lines below the next number.
3. Print the name of the country on the circular cover. Then, draw a picture that represents the country, such as the flag or a well-known landmark.
4. Cut out the question wheel and the circular cover.
5. Glue the question wheel to the center of a paper plate.
6. Place the circular cover on the question wheel and insert a brass fastener through the center.
7. Decorate the outside edge of the paper plate with a design suitable for the country.
