Tim Hallett is an Associate Professor in the Department of Sociology at Indiana University. His research exists at the intersection social psychology, organizations, and culture. Using a paradigm called “inhabited institutionalism”, he examines how institutions are inhabited by people interacting and how these interactions matter for organizational functioning. Currently, Prof. Hallett is developing and inhabited institutional approach to understanding professional socialization, based on a 2-year ethnographic study of a Masters of Public Affairs program. He received his Ph.D. in Sociology in 2003 from Northwestern University.
