- 1 Completed application and *personal statement
- 2 Current resume
- 3 Official undergraduate and graduate transcripts
- 4 Two letters of recommendation; one from a faculty advisor or work supervisor
- 5 GRE or Miller Analogies Test Score (waived for applicants with a Master's Degree or with a 3.0 or higher gpa in their Bachelor's Degree)"
- 6 Application fee of \$55.00

*Please submit a *personal statement* of no more than 2 pages in length. In your statement please discuss:

- 1 Your professional goals in pursuing advanced studies in higher education
- 2 How you see this program helping you achieve your professional goals
- 3 Work and/or academic experiences that have helped prepare you for this program
- 4 Other information that may be of special interest and importance to the admissions committee
