**NOTE:** CCRI students who complete the A.S. in General Business with at least 60 credits and a minimum GPA of 2.0 will be guaranteed admission into the SCE B.A. in Professional Studies. Students must earn a grade of “C” or better to earn transfer credit for each course.

1. Providence College SCE will waive the \$55 application fee for students who meet the above requirements.
2. Students must fulfill the Providence College SCE core curriculum requirements; complete the residency requirement of a minimum of 45 credits in Providence College SCE; and earn at least 50% of their major credits with Providence College coursework.
3. Most students transferring in with the Associate’s in General Business will need approximately 60 credits to complete the bachelor’s degree.
4. It is very important to consult with both CCRI and PC SCE advisers regarding courses that can be transferred from CCRI toward free electives at PC SCE.
