

Thinking of a Major in Business?

Are you interested in exploring business, but don't know which major?

Business majors in the School of Business require the same Business Core Curriculum

The Core Business Courses Include:

ACC 113	Data Applications in Business
ACC 203	Financial Accounting
ACC 204	Managerial Accounting
FIN 207	Managerial Finance I
FIN 217	Statistical Analysis & Business Decisions I
FIN 310	Operations Management I
MGT 301	Organizational Behavior
MGT 330	Legal Environment for Business I
MKT 205	Principles of Marketing

The Business Core Curriculum also includes some courses that meet the College Core Curriculum requirements.

These include:

ECN 101	Principles of Economics – Micro
ECN 102	Principles of Economics – Macro
MTH 108	Mathematics for Business Analysis II

The following courses are typically taken by freshmen and sophomores majoring in business:

- MTH 108 or higher MTH 108 or higher is recommended for Accountancy majors* The following courses will fulfill the Quantitative Reasoning core for Accountancy Majors: MTH 107, MTH 108, MTH 109, MTH 131, MTH 132

All Providence College School of Business (PCSB) students are required to demonstrate proficiency in finite mathematics. As a result, all new and incoming business students must successfully complete MTH 107 (or higher) and ALEKS. ALEKS is an on-line math learning and assessment tool which is used to measure math proficiency and help bring students up to the expected levels on finite math topics. PCSB students will need to complete ALEKS at the 80th percentile by the first day of classes.

PCSB ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All new Providence College School of Business majors (accountancy, finance, management, or marketing) will be required to have at least a 2.5 cumulative overall GPA at the completion of two semesters of academic work at PC to continue in their business major. GPA reviews will take place at the end of each semester during the first two semesters of coursework only. Non-business majors interested in changing their major to business will need at least a 2.5 cumulative overall GPA to enter the School of Business and must attend a mandatory PCSB Declaration of Major session.
