This article presents the results of two studies by D. A. Adams et al designed to replicate previous work by Fred Davis in 1989 regarding perceived usefulness, ease of use, and their influence on the usage of information technology. Specifically, these authors sought to evaluate the psychometric properties of the ease of use and usefulness scales, and empirically examine the relationship between the constructs, or traits, of usefulness, ease of use, and reported levels of usage.
