Components of the application Part B – due no later than **June 6, 2020** by midnight via email.

3. 5-7 pages Context of the Journey (your school story) double-spaced, 12 point font using the 5 Performance Strands as filters (use parenthetical citations of strands and skills, ex. 1.3 embedded in the text of the story), but in the form of a narrative or case study. This story will be a reflective activity, a tool for the principal's communication with various stakeholders, and provide information for the Scoring team regarding the principal's leadership performance. Attach this document to Part B.
Provide one-page of bullet pointed evidence per strand of movement toward scale. Responses should describe practices using evidence-based language - not to exceed 1 page per strand (double-spaced, 12 point font). Attach this document to Part B.
4. Complete the charts and graphs for the student performance section. Attach these documents to Part B.
5. Respond to the following three questions regarding your student achievement data in 2-4 pages of double-spaced, 12 pt. font (this is not per graph, rather holistically summarizing to look for areas of strength and areas of growth utilizing all the charts and graphs):
