



Western Washington University Veteran Completion Waiver

The Revised Code of Washington 28B.15.621 authorizes colleges and universities to waive a portion of tuition and fees for qualifying veterans. Subject to adequate funding, Western Washington University will offer a limited number of tuition waivers, for 100% tuition and mandatory fees for veterans who have exhausted their Post- 9/11 GI Bill®.

CONDITIONS: Veteran students must have completed at least 24 credits while using their Post 9/11 GI Bill® in pursuit of their first Bachelor’s degree during enrollment at WWU. Students may attempt up to 125% of the minimum credit requirements for their baccalaureate program of study, as defined in the University Catalog. No additional allowance is granted for concurrent completion of a double major or an elective minor, unless it is included in official university records at the point of waiver application.

ELIGIBILITY: You are eligible for this waiver if you meet all of the following: you are a veteran who has exhausted all of your Post 9/11 GI Bill®; are currently a Washington State resident; have completed at least 24 credits using your Post 9/11 GI Bill® at Western before it was exhausted and are enrolled as a matriculated student, eligible for graduation with an identified plan of study on file while pursuing your first baccalaureate degree while attending Western Washington University.

PROCEDURES: Complete the application section below and attach notice from the VA indicating your benefits have been exhausted, transcripts verifying you have completed 24 credits at WWU and a copy of your driver’s license or other proof of residency (e.g., utility bill or paystub). The Veteran Services Office will check for plan of study on file, use of GI Bill® benefits for at least 24 credits and eligible for graduation once your form has been submitted.
